MINUTES

1. Apologies for absence were received from Paul Brennan
2. To receive any declarations of interest from Councillors: A declaration of interest was made by Cllr Brenda Mosey for 4(a) and 6(a)

- (a) ZE23/00750/CLEUD, APPLICANT: Ian Mosey Ltd, Certificate of Lawfulness in respect of the activity of vehicle movements in breach of condition 01 of approval 11/00498/73A dated 06.09.2011 for more than 10 years before the date of this application.

The following response was agreed: The most recent decision on this CLEUD in March 2023 should be the start date of future appeals by the business. This was determined in March 2023 and the business has been breaking those regulations ever since.

The response is as previously given to the March 2023 consultation, which is objection.

We understand from neighbouring parish council that the fact that the traffic movements are in contravention of the March 2023 decision will not be enforced by the Planning Authority until after this CLEUD is determined. This means that the business could continuously put in CLEUDs relating to the original one in March 2023 and consequently no enforcement action would ever be taken. This is clearly a very poor situation and local people are being disturbed by the noise of the business waggons with no protection from the regulatory authority.

The Parish Council would like to know when this decision will be taken and if members of the public will be able to attend.
